Driver's Ed and Driver's Training are two parts of a one-semester elective totaling 5 credits. ACA provides this as an alternative to paying a driving school and under our program the parent will be the instructor. The student <u>must be currently enrolled with their registration paid in full</u>. <u>If the student is graduating early</u>, contact the office as soon as possible to make sure you can complete the program while registered with ACA.

NOTE: There is an additional fee for this course:

The fee for this course that includes Drivers Ed (textbook section) and Drivers Training (behind-the-wheel) is \$35.00. This allows you as a parent to teach the total course. You may choose to have your student do only the Driver's Ed <u>or</u> the Driver's Training but the fee is still \$35.00.

<u>Driver's Education</u>: This can be accomplished through:

• An internet training program. Google for reasonably priced programs e.g.:

These programs are listed as examples but not necessarily endorsed by ACA.

- A state approved text book.
 - 1. Obtain a textbook by borrowing or purchasing one.
 - 2. The student completes the textbook, reading the entire book and answering the test questions with each chapter. The parent corrects and discusses the answers.

When your student is at least 15 yrs. old, the parent sends to ACA:

- 1. The \$35 fee (Make checks payable to ACA)
- 2. FULL LEGAL NAME of the student, address and date of birth.
- 3. One of the following:
 - A copy of just the test answers, (no more than 10 random tests)
 - A copy of the online Completion Certificate
 - A copy of the permit, if already obtained.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> If you get your permit and start driving without contacting the office (or pay for a Driver's Training program) you are driving illegally.

I will send the necessary paperwork with a detailed instruction sheet for the student to apply for their permit (must be 15½) and a list of <u>the paperwork that needs to be returned</u> to the office before I can send the student a <u>Driver's Training Certificate of Completion</u>. This certificate will be required when applying for their driver's license.
