JOURNAL DESCRIPTION

As stated in the parent contract from the registration packet, parents are required to keep a daily log or journal of work students complete. We suggest that once your student is in high school you assign the daily writing of the journal to the student. This task may be done by hand on lined paper, by using a copy of the enclosed sample page, or by typing on the computer. The journal needs to record the date, subject studied, page numbers if a textbook is used and the specific idea or principle learned in the lesson. The journal needs to have a title page that lists the student's name, grade, school year and each textbook title and publisher. All high school students will be asked to show their journal to their coordinator or send random copies of several pages if unable to attend a meeting before the end of the school year. Graduates must have the journal personally checked and approved by their coordinator before May 1 in order to be eligible to graduate.
